BOARD JOINT MEETING

AUGUST 30, 2010

A special joint meeting with the DeWitt City Council and Central Community Schools of Clinton County Board was held on August 30, 2010 at Central High School. Mayor Donald J. Thiltgen presiding. Council Members present Marcus, Hasenmiller, Ketelsen, Scheckel and Dunkin.

Discussion – Central Community Schools Facilities Plans regarding Current Expansion, Outdoor Athletic Complex and Future Expansion. A tour of the STAR project was also given to those present.

Discussion – City of DeWitt Capital Improvement Plan and Future Plans. Eleventh (11th) Street project will be next year from the Humeston to the new East entrance of the school area. There will be some detours for businesses in that area and meetings will be held later this year as information is available. Tenth (10th) Street project will be from 5th Avenue to 1st Avenue, with meetings also being held when information is available.

Shared Use & Operations of Future Facilities – An Operations Committee will be put together to get the community use areas known. The Committee would be made up of school board members, council members, community members, school district members and others from the fine arts community. This committee should be up and meeting this winter.

Community Attraction & Tourism (CAT) Grant Update – Negotiations will be held in Iowa City Thursday, September 2, 2010.

The City Council and Central School Board will meet again in six (6) months. Scheckel moved to adjourn at 7:45 p.m.
